Swimming Pool

We are committed to providing important life skills for all children in school and believe having the opportunity to swim from an early age is a necessary life-saving skill. Therefore, when our pop-up pool arrives, we give all children from year 1-6 the chance to develop skills over 4-5 lessons, building their confidence, developing strokes and in year 6 learning water-based life-saving skills.

from parents in KS2. The pool will also be available to hire in the evenings and at weekends.

Year 6 SATs

Next week sees 4 days of testing for our year 6 pupils as they undertake their SATs exams. The children have worked so hard over the year and their progress has been impressive.
