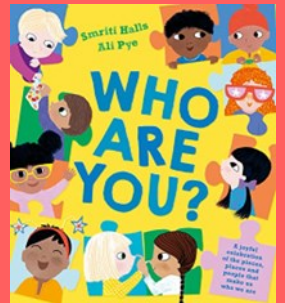

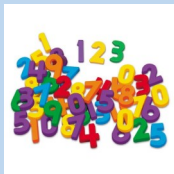
Literacy
